SIGHTSEEING OF THE JEWISH DISTRICT + PLACES RELATED TO SHINDLER'S LIST:

Once the Jerusalem of Europe and intellectual capital for Polish Jews, Kazimierz is certainly one of the 2 best preserved Jewish districts in Europe. Strolling around winding little streets you will find yourself in the secret world of rabbis, miracle-workers, tales and legends, demons and dibbuks. You will also experience the revival of a lively Jewish culture and you will be moved by the same emotions that inspired Steven Spielberg to film "Shindler's List", whose film setting we will be visiting.

. Remuh Synagogue and **Remuh** cemetery – the oldest Jewish cemetery of Poland). Visit of **Szeroka street** – formerly the spiritual centre of the Jewish Town. The Palace of Landau. **Mikveh. Isaac Synagogue** showing two short documentary movies about Jewish Ghetto. Old Synagogue – the Oldest Jewish temple in Poland housing . **Places related to Schindler's List**, the scene of which is laid in Krakow. Courtyard at Józefa street. Shindler's factory. Ciemna street. Walls of the Nazi Ghetto created by the Nazis in 1941.
